





Focus on holistic development and international mindedness





Middle Years Programme (MYP) Age Range: 11-16 years old

Focus: Academic challenge and practical connections

- Eight Subject Groups:
 - Language Acquisition
 - Language and Literature
 - Individuals and Societies
 - Sciences
 - Mathematics
 - Arts
 - Physical and Health Education
 - Design
- Personal Project requirement



Diploma Programme (DP) Age Range: 16-19 years old

Focus: Rigorous preuniversity course

- Six Subject Groups (must choose 1 from each group)
 - Studies in Language and Literature
 - Language Acquisition
 - Individuals and Societies
 - Sciences
 - Mathematics
 - The Arts

Instead of a subject from The Arts, a student can choose an additional subject from one of the other groups.



Diploma Programme (DP) Age Range: 16-19 years old

Core Components:

- Extended Essay (4,000 word research paper)
- Theory of Knowledge (TOK)
- Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS)

Career-related Programme (CP) Age Range: 16-19 years old

Focus: Career-related learning and academic rigor

- Combination of DP courses and careerrelated studies
- CP Core Components:
 - Reflective Project
 - Language Development
 - Service Learning
 - Personal and Professional Skills



Career-related Programme (CP)

1. Core Components:

- **1. Personal and Professional Skills:** Focuses on developing skills needed for lifelong learning and employment.
- **2. Service Learning:** Involves students in community service to develop social awareness and a sense of responsibility.
- **3. Reflective Project:** An in-depth body of work produced over an extended period, reflecting on an ethical issue related to the student's career-related studies.
- **4. Language Development:** Aims to ensure that students have the necessary language skills to communicate in a global society.





Career-related Programme (CP)

2.Career-related Studies:

These are courses related to a particular career path,

- provided by an external provider or
- developed in collaboration with the school.
- They are designed to provide students with both practical and theoretical knowledge in their chosen field.

3.Diploma Programme Courses:

- Students must take at least two Diploma Programme (DP) courses,
- which provide academic rigor and
- prepare students for further education and work.

Career-related Programme (CP) Age Range: 16-19 years old

Holistic Development:

- The CP aims to develop students who are knowledgeable, principled, open-minded, and reflective,
- balancing academic and career-related learning
- with personal development.
